"Circuits" features work by 11 local artists who participated in the WIASC Open Studio Day in mid-August and reveals the creativity and innovation that flourish in the heart of our communities. On view from Sept. 1 through 30, 2025, at the Studio 77 café in Pointe-Claire Village:

"In light of the WIASC aims of making the visual arts more accessible and fostering connections between artists and our West Island communities – outside of sometimes intimidating exhibition spaces – we're delighted that visitors to Circuits will have this opportunity to appreciate local artworks in an informal café setting," says Sandra Woods, WIASC Founder, Disabled artist, and Veteran. "Studio 77 is a popular independent café in the historic Pointe-Claire Village. This cozy, computer-free locale is known for its welcoming atmosphere and for hosting visual arts events and gatherings including live music, drawing sessions and philosophy talks."

Displaying works in a range of mediums, techniques and styles, Circuits will offer visitors a unique opportunity to view a grouping of works by WIASC artists – all of whom have studios in the West Island – with 20% of any sales of artworks donated to On Rock Community Services, for its Food Bank and other programs.

The Studio 77 café is located at 271 Lakeshore Road in Pointe-Claire, open weekdays from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. and on weekends from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. A meet-the-artists "Vernissage" reception will take place on Sunday Sept. 21, from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.

2025 is the debut year for the WIASC, which launched a new annual Open Studio Day across the West Island and is already planning a larger event for 2026.
